

## APPENDIX D: MULTIDISCIPLINARY RESEARCH PROGRAMS

### D.1 Overview

The Office of Space Science (OSS) frequently sponsors program elements that apply across more than one of its four science themes as defined in Section 1 of the *Summary of Solicitation* of this NRA, and such multidisciplinary programs are listed in this section of this ROSS NRA. At the time of the initial release of this NRA, there is only one such program. Any others that are defined during calendar year 2004 will be issued as amendments to this NRA, typically 90 days in advance of their established Proposal Due Dates. Such new programs will be managed by only one OSS Program Officer as designated in the "Programmatic Information" section of each Element, who will be organizationally located in one of the three OSS science Divisions or the OSS Project Prometheus, Nuclear Systems Program Office, and to whom all questions may be directed. At the time of selection all of the OSS Science Divisions that have programmatic interest in the advertised program will be consulted by the designated Selecting Official.
